Day 1-2

Arrive in Kenya:
11th Jan 2020
(Late PM)

Arrival

Get in to the African culture poley poley (slowly!). Welcome party, induction, giraffe centre, David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust, local shopping, transfer up to the bush.

Accommodation: Local guesthouse in the suburb of Karen

Day 3-7

"Farm to Fork" farming on Borana Conservancy

Learn a new method of regenerative farming and the importance of a sustainable technique, working shoulder to shoulder with local people. Daily outdoor work on the farm with a hands-on approach. Example day: Introduction of farming element with demo and task such as mulching, breakfast in camp, 2nd introductory task such as planting seedlings, lunch in camp and down time, afternoon activity, bring in cattle, sundowners and supper.

Accommodation: Fly-camping with showers, beautiful riverside location

Day 8-9

Nanyuki town

Enjoy 2 nights in Nanyuki town, local shopping and bars, Sunday church service, weekend market, women's projects, general down time and movie time.

Accommodation: Local guesthouse in the centre of town

Day 10-14

Field guide and nature training on Il Ngwesi Conservancy

A fully immersive bush experience with the local Maasai community, performing critical data collection and partaking in an introductory field guide course. Example daily routine: Morning bush walks for data collection, relax by pool, afternoon lectures, evening lesson in the bush, sundowners, Maasai dance, song and stories around the firepit or during supper.

Accommodation: Il Ngwesi Lodge (*Opportunity to do one homestay night with the Maasai*)

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<i>Day 15</i>	<i>Nanyuki town</i> Enjoy 1 stop-over night in Nanyuki town, downtime, unwind, evening entertainment. Accommodation: Local guesthouse in centre of town
<i>Day 16-21</i>	<i>'Next Gen' conservation volunteering on Ol Pejeta Conservancy</i> An extensive behind the scenes education on Ol Pejeta's conservation programmes such as: anti-poaching rangers, sniffer dogs, mobile medical clinic, micro-lending program. Be exposed to the challenges of protecting the surrounding wildlife and environment. Meet with heads of departments and enjoy daily game viewing. Accommodation: Guesthouses on the conservancy
<i>Day 22-27</i>	<i>Marine conservation volunteering on the coast with Oceans Alive</i> Beach time! A thorough introduction and education to marine conservation on the beautiful North Kenya coast with daily snorkelling in the community marine sanctuary, morning talks on key marine matters, fish identification, data collection, local welfare projects, coral reforestation and movie nights. Accommodation: On-site guesthouse
<i>Day 28</i> Depart Kenya: 7 th Feb 2020 (Late PM)	<i>Departure</i> Say goodbye to your new found friends and discovered land, and transfer down to Nairobi JKIA international airport for evening flight.
